The 50th IEEE Conference on Decision and Control (CDC) and European Control Conference (ECC) will be held Monday through Thursday, December 12-15, 2011 at the Hilton Orlando Bonnet Creek, Orlando, Florida. The conference will be preceded by technical workshops on Sunday, December 11, 2011.

This conference is special: CDC will celebrate its 50th anniversary and CDC and ECC will be held as a joint conference for the second time. Our successes in the last 50 years testify to the maturity of decision and control as a broad and interdisciplinary discipline. There will be special social events in the evenings, with a whole four days of technical presentations of contributed papers and invited sessions, and an unusually large number of plenary and semi-plenary sessions with distinguished researchers.
